Environmental Sustainability

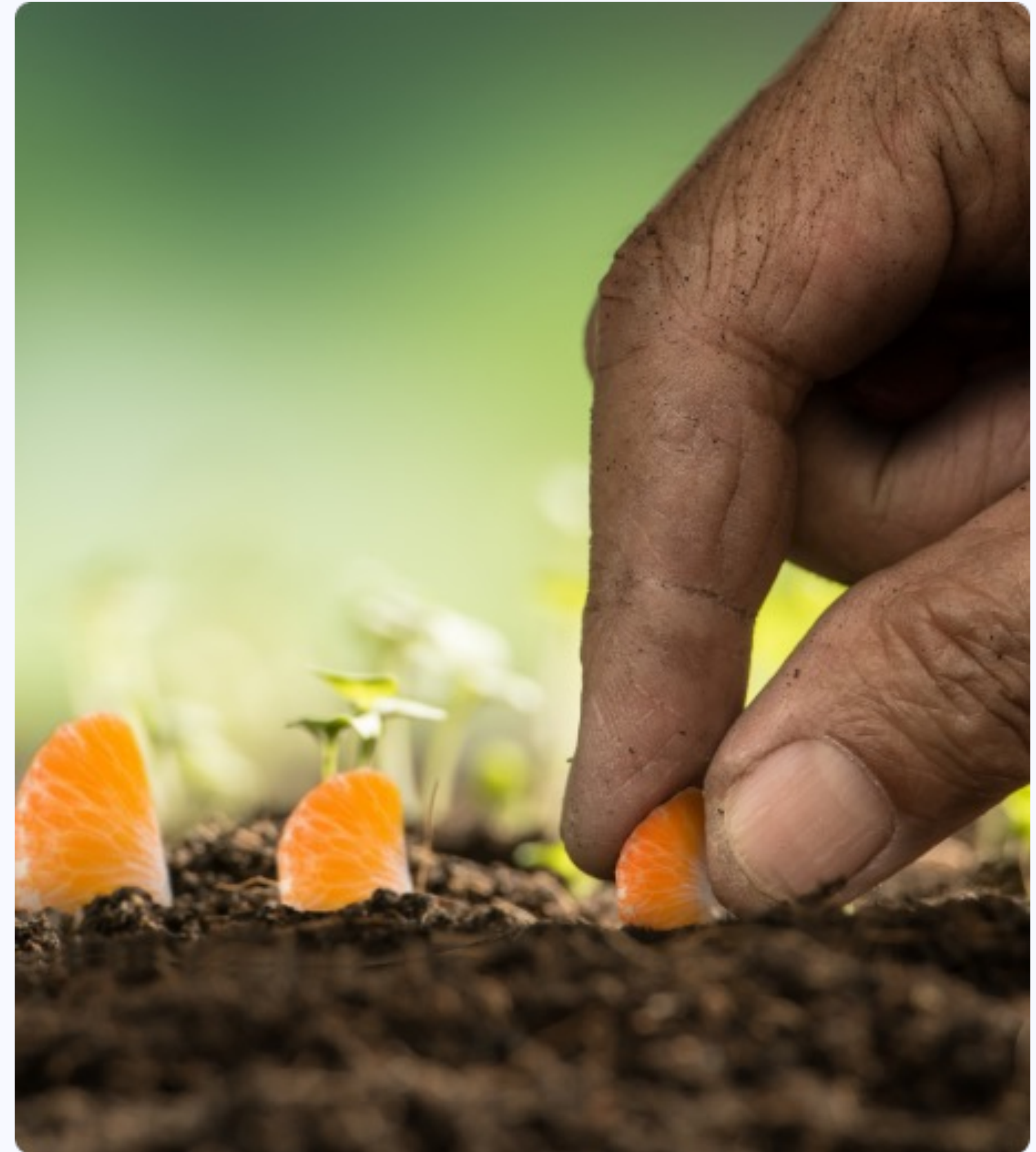
Education

At Tangerine, we have chosen **Recycling** as our major tool to ensure we play our part in this responsibility of preserving our Earth.





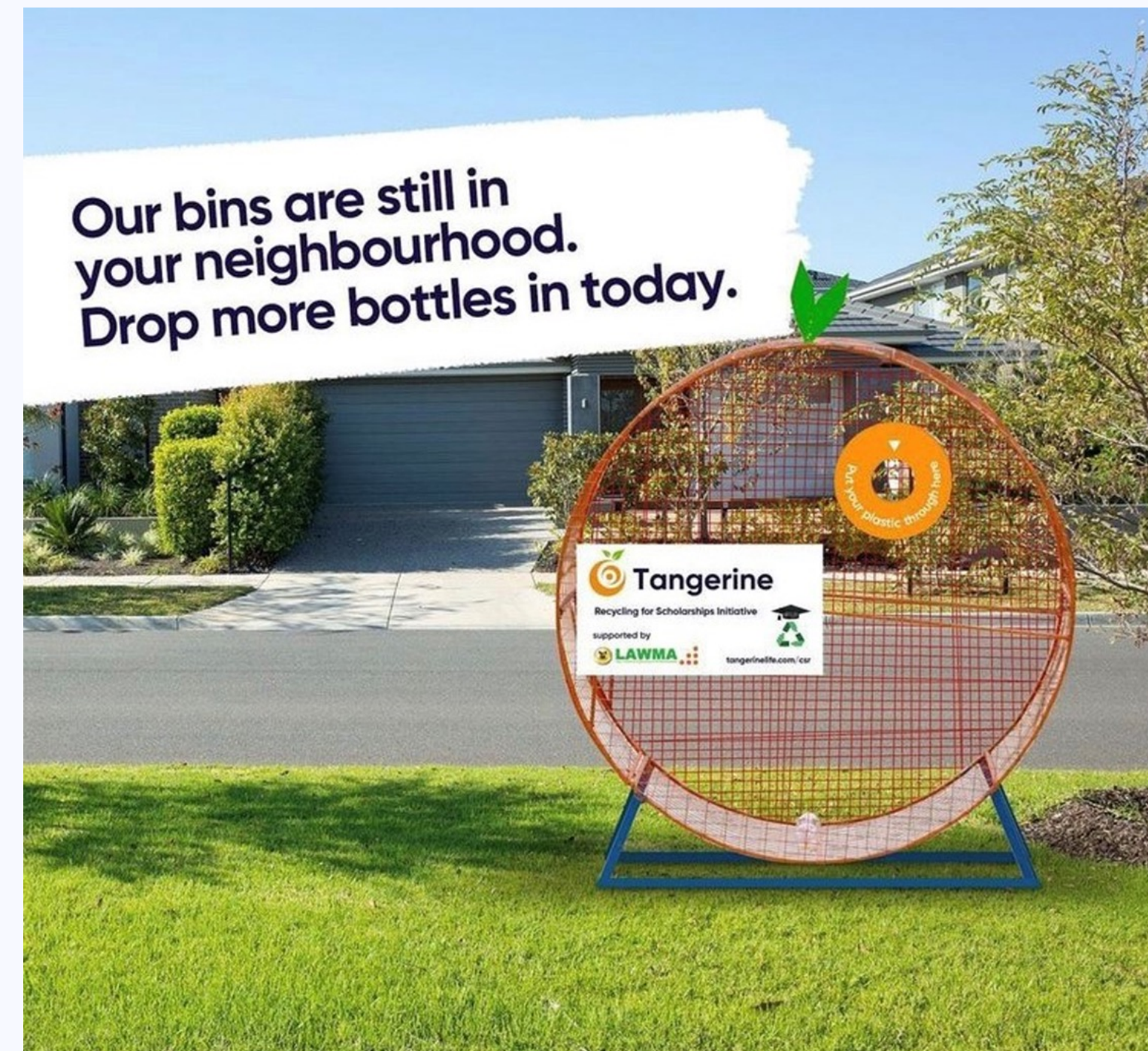
In 2021, in partnership with the Lagos State Waste Management (LAWMA), Tangerine created Mesh bins to collect recyclable items. We currently have over 50 bins across Lagos State.

To make an impact in our community, we first must make an impact in-house and have Staff and stakeholders on board with our goals.

We all need to understand the benefits of living sustainable lifestyles through our individual choices.

Tangerine is committed to sustainable practices and to fulfill the goal set for our Recycling for Scholarships Initiative.

The **Recycling for Scholarships** initiative began in 2020, offering education to students from low-income households while simultaneously keeping the environment clean and safe.

In 2020, about 300 kg of plastics was collected from a recycling drive which was used to send one student to school for the 2020/2021 Academic year – **Miss Yetunde Saheed** of **Isrina School, Ajegunle**.





## WHAT WE HAVE DONE SO FAR

In 2021, we sponsored 20 students to school. We were able to raise money for their tuition through donation from LAWMA and recyclables collected.

The beneficiary schools were ISRINA School and MORIT International school, both in Ajegunle, Lagos state.

The students were presented with certificates, snacks and Tangerine branded items for school. Their parents and school administration were present and expressed gratitude.





Though we experienced some challenges in managing the recycling operations this year, we have been able to collect over **2,000 kg of recyclables**.

Unfortunately, Recyclables do not have the highest value so sometimes we may not even get up to N 1,000 from a full mesh bin.

One of the beneficiary schools - ISRINA School - shared the report card of the students we sponsored. They are performing excellently!

## WHAT'S NEXT?

Last year in 2021, we paid for only the tuition fees of these students. But this year, we want to be able to pay for other expenses to keep them in school like their uniforms and books.

The average amount required to sponsor a child to school for a whole academic year is roughly N 60,000.

At the **TANG GREEN DRIVE** happening this Saturday 3<sup>rd</sup> September, we will be organizing a Recycling Drive. This will give us a chance to raise enough funds to sponsor kids to school. We are already behind on our time and amount we need.

There are 2 ways you can show support:

- Bring ALL your used PET water and Soda bottles. We have a target to raise 5,000kg of plastic recyclables during this event.
- Adopt a child to donate part or whole of their fees for the academic year 2022/2023.

If you decide to donate cash, the Tangerine Bank account will be shared, and all monies will be sent there. It is a transparent process, and no one will be able to claim the monies received.

We will also share a report stating how much was raised through this drive and how much was spent on the kids.

No amount is too small, and every penny is sincerely appreciated as it will definitely put a smile on the faces of the kids.

An additional way to be of great help is to please spread the word about this cause through Word of Mouth and your Social media handles. Encourage continuous participation by your friends and family to keep using our mesh bins close to them. And ask them to be a part of the Recycling Drive and drop off their plastics on Saturday.
